- Bucks County Health Improvement Partnership (BCHIP) was developed by the 6 hospitals in Bucks County to find and fill community health needs
- Current work with our Healthcare Staffing Collaboration has found a large gap in healthcare staffing in allied health positions

Why Allied Health Professions?

- Allied health professionals are valued members of the healthcare system that provide a range of **diagnostic**, **technical**, **therapeutic**, **and support services**
- This is a fitting job option for those who enjoy **helping others** or want more **exposure to the health industry**
- There are many positions available locally that do not need previous training
 - If training is needed, there are many programs available at less cost than traditional college tuition to create a pathway to competitive compensation and benefits
